

Call for the position of:

Expert in process mapping and data architecture

Anglo-American University, announces a search to fill the full-time or part-time position of expert in process mapping and data architecture. Concept:

AAU is in search of a new Student Information System, for which it has conducted a basic data-flow analysis. Building on that, it intends to map all processes and current data architecture in depth, analyze the data architecture, and categorize processes according to the importance and possibility of changing them. The resulting analysis will be used to assess available IS platforms and select the most compatible solution.

Responsibilities:

- Map all current processes and data used across departments
- Identify core and optional functionalities
- Identify possible data and process duplicities in currently used systems
- Identify missing functionalities and data currently handled manually. Specify frequency of such situations and estimate corresponding time costs
- Describe the current study information system and related systems with regard to the future data transfer to a Data Warehouse or to a new IS
- Design an efficient IT system to meet business and technology needs
- Integrate multiple systems and reconcile needs of different teams
- Provide advice and technical training.

- Understanding of one or more process mapping languages (BPMN, UML, ERD, DFD)
- Experience as an IT Analyst, IT Consultant or similar role
- Experience in project management
- Analytical mindset (with problem-solving aptitude)
