

# **Senior Lecturer and Researcher in Psychology**

The lecturer will be responsible for teaching BA and MA level courses to a culturally diverse student body, specifically courses in the fields of Social Psychology and/or Organizational Psychology. The lecturer will be responsible for advising BA and MA theses and for guiding student research projects. In addition, the lecturer will be expected to produce significant, grant-supported research and to be engaged in scholarly outreach on both national and international levels, as well as to engage in AAU committees.
