


About AAU


Central Location

Safety and Affordability




AAU Study Abroad Options

Based on the offered collaborations with partner universities and other institutions, and the type of program chosen, students can either receive home university or AAU academic credit.

Semester Abroad Program

- Duration: One Fall or Spring Semester (students can apply for up to a year)
- Capacity: 8 25 students per class, "free movers" accepted
- Academic Content: Up to 5 AAU classes counting towards home university degree
- Credits: Min. 3 US credits per AAU course
- Extra-curricular: 2 Prague half-day activities, 1 out-of-Prague excursion
- Additional Services: Special support by AAU Study Abroad Office

Short Term Study Abroad Program

An intensive program for individual students or cohorts with academic and extra-curricular content.

- Time of the year: January or June
- Duration: One 3-week term
- Capacity: 8-25 students per class, "free movers" accepted
- Academic Content: 1 AAU course counting towards home university degree
- · Credits: Min. 3 US credits per AAU course
- Extra-curricular: 1 Prague tour
- Additional Services: Special support by AAU Study Abroad Office
- Housing: AAU housing facilities

Global Summer School Program

An attractive summer program for individual students or student cohorts with a choice of catchy topics and extracurricular activities.

- Time of the year: Summer (July/August)
- **Duration**: Two 3-week summer school sessions
- Capacity: 10-30 students per summer school course
- Academic Content: 1 AAU course per summer school session
- Credits: 3 US credits per course
- **Extra-curricular**: 2 academic visits, 2 Prague half-day activities, 1 out-of-Prague excursion

- Housing: AAU housing facilities or alternative housing options

Customized Summer and Winter Schools

A customized short term program specifically for student cohorts tailored to the needs and expectations of both students and partner universities.

- Time of the year: Winter (January) or Summer (July)
- Duration: 4-week program

- Academic Content: 2 AAU courses
- Credits: 3 US credits per course
- **Extra-curricular**: Upon agreement
- Additional Services: Special support by AAU Study Abroad Office
