

Call for the position of:

Lecturer in International Relations with focus on International Law

The School of International Relations and Diplomacy, Anglo-American University, announces a search to fill the full-time position of Lecturer in International Relations. The position is open to active scholars who have a track record of publications in peer reviewed outlets (or for early career scholars, can provide evidence of an emerging trajectory of scholarly publishing).

Responsibilities:

- Up-to-date academic CV, including

 - List of other academically relevant outputs in the field of expertise – public outreach, activity serving the larger community (consultancy, advising, reviewing, dissemination of knowledge, or other forms of engagement) etc.
 - List of courses taught and recent teaching scores (evaluations)
- Short listed candidates will be required to submit two reference letters.
