

ACADEMIC 1 2024-2025 | Fall Semester Year Timeline





Academics & Accreditations

AAU is the first institution in Europe to have received the prestigious <u>WSCUC</u> <u>accreditation</u>, an American accrediting agency that is recognized by the US government. This Accreditation allows for each of our students to graduate with an American degree, and open doors to a vast global and educational market. AAU degree programs are also accredited

ANGLO AMERICAN UNIVERSITY by the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sports of the Czech Republic or the National Accreditation Bureau for Higher Education in the <u>Czech Republic</u>. This accreditation gives degrees obtained at AAU wide recognition throughout Europe due to the Czech Republic's membership in the European Union. This accreditation allows students the opportunity to graduate with an EU degree.

DEGREE STRUCTURE


Undergraduate degrees at AAU are 90 US credits, designed to be completed in three years when studying full-time. All programs culminate with a thesis project, allowing

students to conduct research into a specific aspect of their studies, demonstrating mastery of the subject.

STUDY STRUCTURE

Our undergraduate programs follow a modular structure, composed of blocks of courses dedicated to achieving different learning outcomes. This variability allows students to take a more tailored approach to their studies.

TRANSITION to Campus

NEW STUDENT MENTORS PROGRAM & STUDENT ORIENTATION

JOURNEY TO AAU Visa Procedures

Everyone's journey to AAU is different. If your student is not an EU citizen or Czech National and does not possess an EU passport, they will most likely need to obtain a visa in order to study in the Czech Republic.

AAU recommends that students schedule a meeting with an Admissions Counselor as soon as they receive their decision from AAU. Our Admissions Counselors will be able to provide you with the guidance to begin the visa process.

PROCESS OF Nostrification

At AAU we offer dual degree programs, which includes both US and EU degrees. In order for some students to be eligible for the EU degree track, they must undergo the process of Nostrification.

Nostrification is a state-administered process that compares a students foreign education to a Czech education on the same level to validate that the education is equal. Your student's education will be compared to one of the standard programs of Czech secondary education or bachelor's education and matched if equivalent.

The process of nostrification is different for each student and AAU is here to help!

AAU has a dedicated <u>nostrification specialist for students to help</u> them with any questions they may have throughout the process. Students can choose to begin the process as soon as they arrive on campus by reaching out to our Nostrification specialist.

Although Nostrification is not required, there are some benefits to graduating with our Dual US and EU degree. For example:

- The ability to work as a student
- Multiple-month visa-free stay in the EU for job searching post-graduation
- Ability to participate in Erasmus And more!

Students who hold some degrees are exempt from this process. These degrees include Czech, German, Hungarian, Polish, Slovak, Slovenian, and European baccalaureate high school diplomas.

Not only is Prague renowned for its stunning beauty, but it's also recognized for its exceptional safety. Nonetheless, we understand that unforeseen events can occur, and at AAU, we are committed to providing our community with comprehensive resources to address any obstacles.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Ensuring your student has appropriate health insurance while attending AAU is crucial for their well-being. Below is some essential information to help you navigate the insurance options and requirements:

Insurance Provider Options

Students applying for a long-term visa or stay in the Czech Republic can now choose from multiple authorized insurance providers. While PVZP remains a reliable option, other recommended providers include AXA and SV Pojišťovna.







Increased Indemnity Limits

The coverage limit for health insurance has been significantly increased to **EUR 400,000** per insured incident. This enhancement offers greater financial security in case of medical emergencies.

Your child's health and well-being during their stay in the Czech Republic are our top priorities. We are here to help you every step of the way.

Comprehensive Coverage and Pre-existing Health Conditions

Comprehensive health care coverage includes essential medical services, hospital transfers, hospitalization, prescription medications, repatriations (with limits), and emergency care. Dental care is also covered up to specified limits. It is important to note that the comprehensive coverage options assume a full state of health without pre-existing conditions. If you have a pre-existing health condition that you wish to have covered, please be aware that PVZP is the only company currently offering this option for an additional charge, subject to their assessment.

MAKING APPOINTMENTS

Students with PZVP medical insurance seeking a doctor or to schedule an appointment should always use the provided assistance line. Failure to make this call may result in the denial of medical expense claims. The assistance service will schedule the next available appointment with the doctor or specialist they need.



The building has 7 floors, 111 total rooms, and the possibility to choose from double or single rooms. Accommodation is offered for the full Fall or Spring semester, as well as for the entire academic year. If capacity allows, students can also be accommodated in the Winter and Summer terms as well. Each room comes fully equipped with all the necessary furniture and appliances to make moving to Prague as smooth as possible!
